This person is the primary manager of Redemption volunteers. The Director of Operations works closes with the Lead Pastor to execute given projects and tasks. This role requires significant attention to detail. *The Director of Operations must reflect Christ in word and deed, consistently pursuing holiness.*

Essential Duties & Responsibilities:

- Oversee, recruit, assist, and train all Sunday morning volunteers
- Primary overseer of Sunday morning & special events details
- Create and oversee plan for the entrance and exit of weekly attendees
- Primary creator and manager of planning center service plans
- · Manage all church property needs including cleaning companies, repairs, etc
- Manage, replace, and oversee church equipment as needed
- · Primary engineer of service teams
- Oversee the production of any Sunday service-related and corporate documents as needed
- Support church and ministry leaders in accomplishment of organizational and operational goals
- Consistent bulk shopping to supply church needs
- Host all guest speakers and guest worship leaders as needed
- Develop plan for new visitor follow-up
- Overseeing projects and accomplishing tasks as determined by Lead Pastor
